<u>Water Test: 2025</u> This year's logo is Make a Splash. Merchandise (t shirts, hoodies, bags, drinkware) up on the website and in the premium list. Premium will come out in a few weeks. <u>Water Workshop:</u> The Water Workshop will be held on June 21 and 22 in Montrose, MI. Saturday will cover the basics, while Sunday will focus on advanced techniques. The cost to attend is \$40 for members and \$55 for non-members. Dry camping is available on-site. Bag lunches will be offered for \$5 each, and an order form will be available on Monday. Regional Specialty 2026: For next year's Regional Specialty, we're exploring changes to boost participation. One option is to hold two specialties and scale back on trophies to help manage costs. If we opt for a concurrent specialty (unlike the designated all-breed Regional we're doing this year), we could host our own event and include VN without paying for an additional concurrent show.
